He also referred to Teleconsult's success in the BICTA 2004 and also the successful representation of Brunei Darussalam at the Asia Pacific InfoCommunications Awards (APICTA 2004) held in SAR Hong Kong, PRC and winning of the APICTA eGovernment and Services 'Special Mention' Award.

To encourage establishment of new companies, one new category has been introduced this year, namely the 'Start up company' award.

Besides the encouraging response of participants, the content and quality of the ICT projects have also increased and half of the participants for this year's BICTA come from students from Primary level, Secondary level, Higher Learning Institutions, Technical and Vocational schools, he added

Aside from grabbing a cash prize, trophy and plaque for each win, Teleconsult Sdn. Bhd., will again be representing Brunei Darussalam at the Asia Pacific InfoCommunications Awards 2005 (APICTA), scheduled to be held in February 2006.
