# BICTA winners to represent Brunei Darussalam at APICTA in HK

Winners of this year's Brunei ICT Awards (BICTA) will be representing Brunei Darussalam at the Asia Pacific ICT Awards 2004 (APICTA) to be held in Hong Kong today until December 10, 2004.

Pehin Dato Paduka Hj Abdullah bin Begawan Mudim Dato Paduka Haji Bakar, Permanent Secretary at the Ministry of Communications cum National Chairman of Brunei ICT Awards High Level Committee, was at the Brunei International Airport yesterday to send off the Bruneian contingent led by Mr Ang Kian Guan, Director of IT, Research & Development, Ministry of Communications. Mr Ang is also a member to the Asia Pacific ICT Awards Network (APICTAN).

The winners of BICTA 2004, who were announced during the BICTA Gala Night on November 26, are scheduled to conduct a presentation about their project in Hong Kong, followed by a 10-minute Q&A session with nominees from the Asia Pacific in nine separate categories such as Education & Training, e-Government & Services, Industrial Applications, Financial Applications, General Applications, Media & Entertainment, Research & Development, Tertiary Institution Students Project and Secondary School

## Student Project.

Along with the winners, judges from the BICTA 2004 will also be heading to Hong Kong as they are part of the judging team for APICTA 2004.

Mr Ang said that Brunei's participation at the APICTA will give the contestants the opportunity to be exposed to competition on international stage with a view to also showcase what Brunei Darussalam is capable of. At this point in time Brunei foraying into the development of infrastructure in this field over the last few years has already seen a handful of companies capable of competing internationally at the APICTA.

Teleconsult Sdn. Bhd, is one of the leading lights that shall be shining brightly for Brunei this year. A local company who have designed a programme called 'ePLATO', which is suited for eGovernment, eHealth, eLearning and other General Applications, hopes to challenge for top prize in the eGovernment category in Hong Kong.
